

What is MiDAS?



MiDAS is the Minibus Driver Awareness Scheme, organised by the Community Transport Association U.K. (CTA) which promotes a nationally recognised standard for the assessment and training of minibus drivers. It is a membership based scheme that has been designed to enhance minibus driving standards and promote the safer operation of minibuses. Membership is free.

Only MiDAS accredited drivers are permitted to drive BCT vehicles.

We hold regular MiDAS training sessions here at East Lane.

We can also deliver the training at your organisations preferred location provided a minimum of 3 trainees can attend.

Standard MiDAS induction involves a one day training session comprising a Theory (classroom) module and an on road driving assessment.

For clients working with wheelchair users there is an additional module for accessible transport. This involves a half day session with theory and practical instruction.

BCT provides affordable Minibus Driver Awareness Scheme (MiDAS) accredited training to individuals and organisations so that they can hire BCT or similar vehicles provided for hire by other organisations, or their own vehicles.
